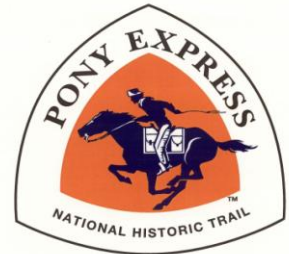

Ron Bell was raised in northern Pennsylvania on a dairy farm and moved to Long Beach California where he attended high school. Ron has military experience stateside and in Korea and after his service moved back to California and worked in the oilfields as a mechanic working on land and offshore rigs. He has owned several companies including an oil rig repair company and welding automation systems house. He has been involved in oil rig construction management in California, Texas, Mexico and Trinidad; and engineering projects including disaster resistant homes in Texas, New Orleans and Indonesia.

Ron continues to lead an extremely busy life doing engineering for different companies around the US and training on SCIP panels (disaster resistant construction panels). He has been the Chamber President in Silver Springs for the last few years, and had a talk show on KSVL for about six months. Larry McPherson got him to help repair the Rider on the Hill in Mound House, and that led him to riding the Pony Express. Ron is now Vice President of the Nevada Division. He finished a novel on the Pony Express last year, the first in a series of three. *The Pony Express Rider* is book one in the Ronnie Campbell Series. The second book is about two thirds finished and will be titled *Ruby Gold*.
